The exciting curriculum is based around the seven Early Learning Goals and the characteristics of effective learning, and is enriched with a wide range of other activities including: music, computer science; assemblies; performance; trips and outings. The Early Years Foundation Stage at Willow Brook includes Nursery (3 to 4 year olds) and Reception (4 to 5 year olds). Children can begin school from 3 years, and are able to attend on a part-time or full-time basis during the Nursery Years. School is full-time in Reception when children reach the age of 5. Parents and younger siblings are welcome, too! We have frequent 'stay and play' sessions when we invite parents to learn with their children, as well as parental workshops, celebration events and the opportunity to join our wonderful PTA and help run Summer, Spring and Winter fairs and other events.

Every pupil is supported to become a thoughtful, caring and creative individual, fully prepared to take their next steps towards a successful future.

Each child has a dedicated Key Worker who is responsible for constantly evaluating their progress and development. This ensures swift progress for all. All pupil work is recorded in a special book which is available for you to see whenever you would like, and which we encourage parents to add to.

The outdoor area is organised particularly well, with a wide range of activities which children can explore independently and are linked to the current topics and themes. The 'mini-beasts' area was very popular and was promoting considerable discussion around identifying different insects and recording the differences through pictures and writing.

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
