A very warm welcome to our new Nursery children and families. Most of our children have started now for this term. We have been having so much fun getting to know each other, playing, exploring and learning together.


Our learning theme for the first half of term is "All about me". We will be reading books, telling stories and singing songs about ourselves, our families and our interests.
